Rule number to be changed: Constitution Section 7

Current rule

7.1 Right to Vote

All Members with voting rights are entitled to vote at the AGM or an EGM in person only. Only those who have held membership with voting rights for more than 30 days prior to an EGM or AGM shall be entitled to vote

Proposed Change:

7.1 Right to Vote

All Members with voting rights are entitled to vote at the AGM or an EGM in person only. Only those who have held membership with voting rights for more than 30 days prior to an EGM or AGM shall be entitled to vote. To be entitled to vote, a member must be an active club member and have attended 5 race or practice days in the calendar year.

Reason:

To ensure those that are active within the club only get a say in how the club is run, and stop any possibility of the club being “taken over” by non-racers.
